

VI. Reading Comprehension: (20Ms)

Read the following passage then answer the questions below:

Most Japanese students do not go to school by cars. Many of them walk or ride bicycles if the distance is not too great. In other cases, students must take public buses and trains, often changing them many times in order to reach their schools. It is common for students to spend two or more hours each day on public transportation.

After intermediate school, students attend secondary schools based on their examination grades. Some secondary schools may be far from where the students live. Some students travel a great distance to attend the school. The school day begins at 8:30, so some students leave home as early as 6:30. Some of them sleep or study during their long way to school. Public transportation provides a chance for socializing with other students.

Student behavior on the way to school is controlled by school rules. These rules prevent some activities in public like chewing gum, eating snacks and reading books while walking. Each school has a unique uniform that makes its students easily known. School rules often require students to stand on buses and trains; leaving seats open for other passengers in order to show respect to others. The Japanese education system is one of the most powerful ways to shape Japanese youth.
