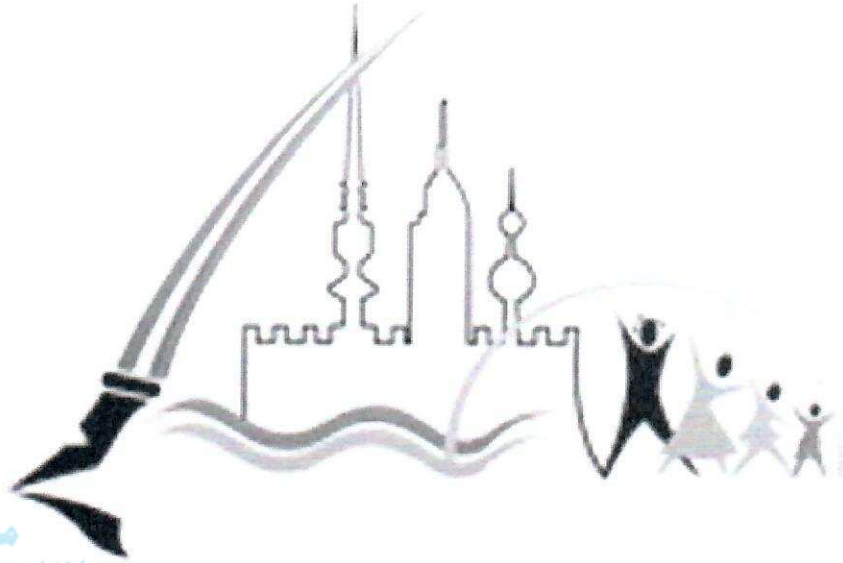

Macaw is a bird that is a part of the parrot family. Macaw birds have bright colours like red, yellow, and blue. People like them because of their special talents. Macaw birds can **mimic** human talk; which means they can say some words people usually say. They might be small or large. Some weigh less than one kilo and are shorter than twenty centimeters. Others can weigh more than two kilos and grow up to one meter tall. All macaw birds have strong toes that are used to grab branches.

Macaw birds live in the rainforest and can live up to eight years. They eat nuts, seeds and berries from the forest. They have hard beaks which help them break the nuts. They can also use their strong tongue because **it** has a bone in it. Macaw birds travel in big groups called flocks. The female birds lay eggs while the male birds hunt for food. They speak to each other by making loud calls. They usually sleep in flocks in the trees.
