Many people think the English found out about curry from people in India in the 1600s. In fact, rich English people were eating dishes made with curry spices hundreds of years before **they** travelled to India. Shown in the English cook books in 1377, the word “curry” was found first in England.

As for pizza, this dish was probably first made by people in Iran. They were eating round, flat bread with cheese in the 500s. That was nearly 1,000 years before pizza caught on in Italy.

Finally, let’s look at the truth behind burgers. Many people think burgers are an American food. However, according to some stories, burgers came from Hamburg, Germany. A German named Otto Kuasw **created** the first burger in 1891. Four years **later**, German sailors introduced burgers to Americans.

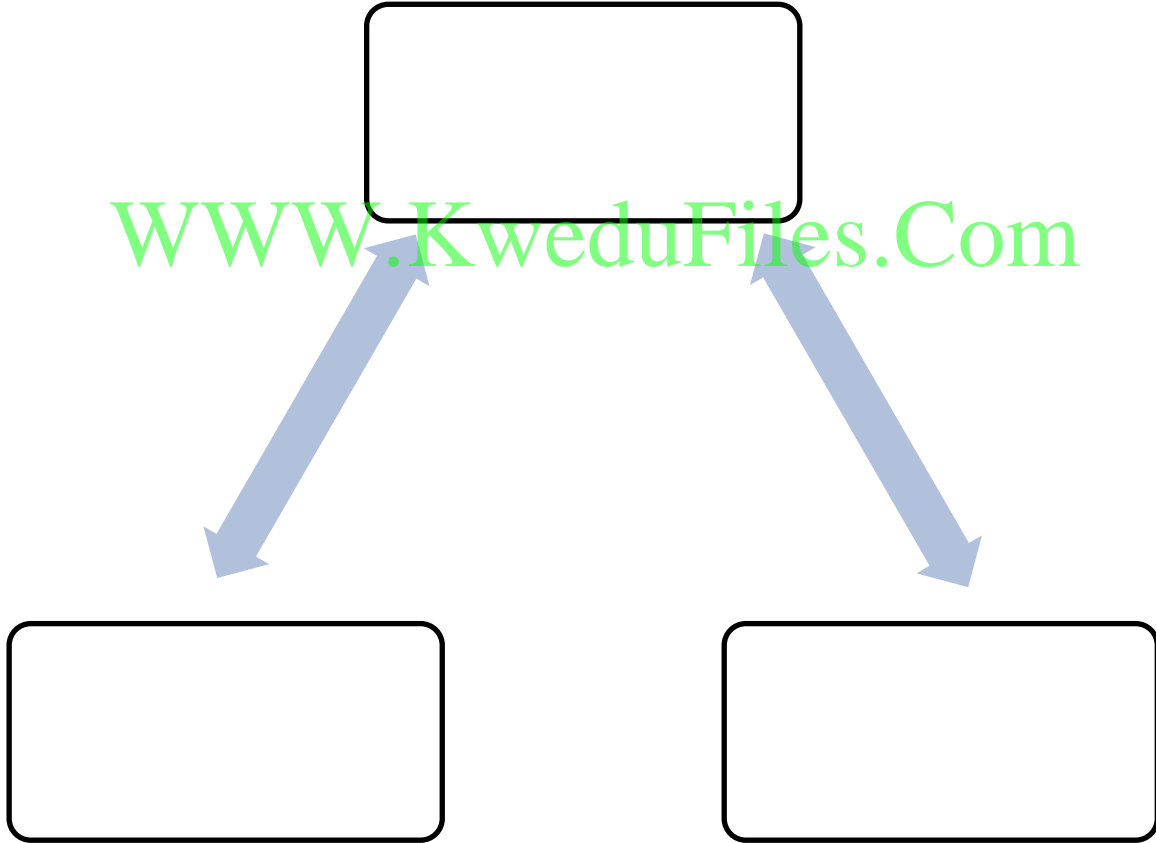


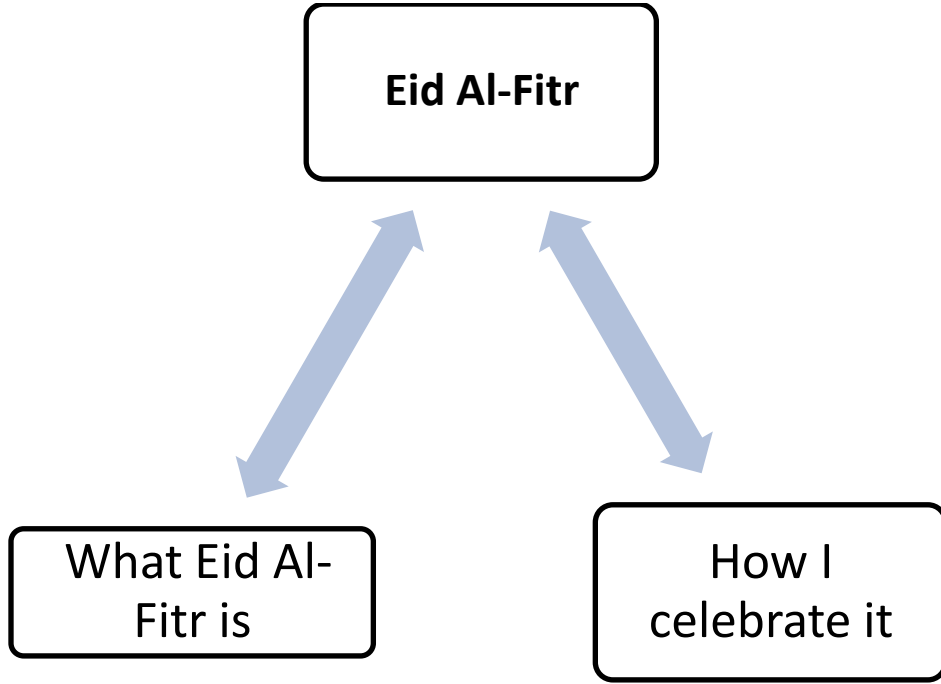
