Zebras are among the most beautiful animals on earth. With their bold black-and-white stripes, they stand apart from other African animals. They roam freely over the large African grasslands. Many people don't know it, but the zebra is one of the few wild horses left in the world today. All horses, including zebras, belong to the same animal group, known as Equus.



Zebras are shorter than most other horses and their ears are larger but, are zebras black with white stripes or white with black stripes? In fact, they are black with white stripes. If you shaved a zebra, it would be almost completely black! You would hardly recognize it. Only zebras have stripes-even their manes are stripped!

One of the most commonly asked questions about this animal is, what does a zebra sound like? Do they sound like horses or donkeys? The answer is that zebras do often sound a lot like donkeys, but they sometimes make rather unusual noises. These noises can be made for a wide variety of reasons, including greeting other zebras or warning threats to stay away.

Many zebras have been killed for their beautiful skins. Fortunately, things are being done to protect zebras now. African governments and wildlife groups have set up nature preserves, where zebras can live without the risk of being hunted.
