



Both brothers were good pupils but because of problems at home, they did not finish high school. They learned by reading many books in their house and they used to ask questions about whatever they thought was interesting.

As they were **bright** mechanics, they decided to open a bicycle shop to sell and repair bicycles. In their free time they first built kites. The brothers' dream was to build the first engine-powered flying machine. **They** designed and built their own engines and fans. Then they did many experiments until the historical date of December 17, 1903, on which Orville was the first person to fly an airplane called "Flyer 1". The flight lasted only 12 seconds and covered just 120 feet.

In 1909, the brothers opened a factory to make aircrafts. Unfortunately, Wilbur died in 1912. He did not live long enough to see how planes improved, but Orville lived till 1948 and saw how the airplane changed the world and our lives.


