Potato chips are thin slices of potato. They are cooked in hot oil until they become crispy. But some are baked or air-fried to be healthier. People love to eat them as snacks or side dishes with meals. Chips can be salty, spicy, or have flavours such as cheese, barbecue, or vinegar. Today, chips are sold in bags, and you can find **them** in many shops around the world.



Potato chips were originally created by accident in 1853 in New York, USA. A chef named George Crum worked in a restaurant called Moon's Lake House. One day, a customer complained that his order was not good and sent it back. George, who did not like negative comments, became annoyed and decided to slice his potatoes very thinly, fry them in oil, and add more salt to make the customer angry. He wanted to teach him a lesson. However, the customer was very happy with the crispy potatoes, and that was the beginning of potato chips. George's sister also worked in the kitchen, and some people believe she was the true inventor of the chips because cutting potatoes very thinly was her idea.

George Crum was known for his cooking skills. So, after the chips became popular, he opened his own restaurant. Even though he did not focus on the chips, many people came just to enjoy them. His chips were known as Saratoga Chips.

In the beginning, chips were sold in glass jars, but that could not keep them fresh. However, in 1926, people started using paper bags because they kept chips fresh, they were cheaper to make, and lighter to carry. Later, machines were developed to peel potatoes and fry chips more **efficiently**.

Potato chips are popular in Kuwait too, and they are enjoyed by people of all ages. In fact, the first company to produce and sell chips locally was FICO in the late 1970s. Today, KITCO is the largest and most recognised chips brand in the country. A newer company, Hectares, is gaining attention for its quality and innovation, and is seen as a promising name in the chips industry.
