We use 'wish' + past simple to express that we want a situation in the present (or future) to be different.

Examples:

- 1- I wish I spoke Italian. (I don't speak Italian.)
- 2- I wish I had a big car. (I don't have a big car.)

wishes about the past

We use 'wish' + past perfect to express a regret, or that we want a situation in the past to be different.

Examples:

- 1- I wish I hadn't eaten so much. (I ate a lot.)
 - 2-I wish I had studied harder at school. (I was lazy at school.)



After a short rest and light meal, they began their descent. Nazri complained of feeling dizzy. He collapsed soon after and never regained consciousness. Travel in space is one of the greatest adventures in history. For hundreds of years, people dreamt about travelling in space, just as they dreamt of flying.

Space scientists were always looking for the possibility of sending human beings into outer space. After experimenting with animals, it was time for the first manned space mission. The first successful manned space mission was launched by Russia on April 12,1961, carrying a young man Known as Yuri Gagarin. The spacecraft was Vostok 1, and it orbited around the earth in 1 hour 48 minutes. One month later, the united states launched their first manned space mission with astronaut Alan Shepard, who managed to complete suborbital flight. John Glen achieved his first flight on February 20,1962.

Space travel has been possible only since suitable rockets were developed in the 1950s. Space travel has many problems. In the past, two problems were more difficult than any others. The first was making an engine that was able to work in space, where there is no oxygen. The other was making an engine powerful enough. Both of these problems were solved by the development of the rocket.

No petrol-engined aircraft can fly in space. A rocket engine is more powerful than any other type of engines. <u>It</u> carries its own oxygen which needed to burn its fuel. It can move a spaceship fast enough to escape the gravity of earth. The force of gravity makes objects fall to the ground when they are dropped. The minimum speed required to escape from this gravity is 40,000 kilometers an hour.

The first objects carried into space by rockets were satellites and probes. Later, human being travelled into space in spaceships. Rockets carried these objects into space. Now they travel round the earth like **artificial** moons. The satellites and probes help scientists to forecast future weather conditions. They also carry radio and television broadcasts to every country in the world. Some take pictures of other planets, the sun, black holes, dark matter or faraway galaxies. These pictures help scientists better understand the solar system and **universe**. Still other satellites are used mainly for communications such as beaming TV signals and phone calls around the world.
