However, smoking not reduces the chances of you becoming obese, which is actually a major cause for many cancers. Genetics can play a big role in cancer development. When cancer is **genetic**, a mutated gene has been passed down. However, it does not mean you will develop it but only have a greater chance of developing it. The environment you are in can cause cancer. Exposure to asbestos for example, is bad for you. Studies have shown that people who are exposed to high amount of benzene, a chemical found in smoking and polluted air, are also at risk for cancer Skin cancer is caused by exposure to the ultra-violet (UV) rays of the sun. Sunburn or tan is actually the result of cell damage caused by the sun.

Skin cancer is preventable. Wearing sunscreen when outdoors and staying out of the sun between the hours of 10 am and 2 pm, when the sun's rays are strongest are your best defense.
