Learning has always been important in Kuwait. Kuwait's educational journey began in the early 20th century. Before formal schools, education in Kuwait was very simple and took place in "Al-Katatib," where students learned to read, write, and recite the Quran. These unofficial schools were usually held in mosques and homes. The teachers were called mullah and muttawa. **They** were well-liked and respected by their students.

The first **modern** school in Kuwait, Al-Mubarakiya School, opened in 1911. It was named after Sheikh Mubarak Al-Sabah, the ruler of Kuwait at the time. Al-Mubarakiya offered subjects like maths, Arabic, history, and geography. The school was the beginning of education in Kuwait and played an important role in shaping the school system.

In 1921, a second school, Al-Ahmadiya, was opened. Education for girls started much later. The first girls' school opened in 1937 next to Al-Mubarakiya School. In 1950 Al-Qurain school for girls was opened. These early schools helped build Kuwait's modern education system, which continues to grow and develop. Kuwait continues to honour the days of Al-Katatib by naming some of the new schools after the well-known mullahs or muttawas.
