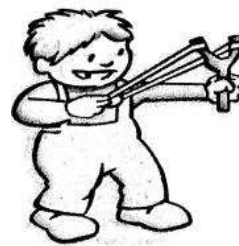

The human body is like a machine that is moving and working all the time. All machines need fuel to give them energy. The fuel for the human body is food and most of the energy comes from **it**. The most important substances in our food are carbohydrates and fats. Carbohydrates are found in food like potatoes, bread, rice, wheat, corn, etc. and sugar. Fats come from food like cheese, butter, oil and meat.

Energy in food is measured in calories. For example, an apple has about 40 calories, and an egg has about 80 calories, a fresh date has 15 calories, and a tomato has around 12 calories. Carbohydrates and fats have a lot of calories. All “junk food” contains a lot of carbohydrates and fats. People like eating this kind of food more than all the other kinds because it is **cheaper** and more attractive.

You need about 40 calories a day for each kilo that you weigh. So if you weigh 60 kilos, you will need about 2400 calories per day. If a person eats more calories than he needs, his body stores the extra calories as fat. That is how some people become fat and overweight.
