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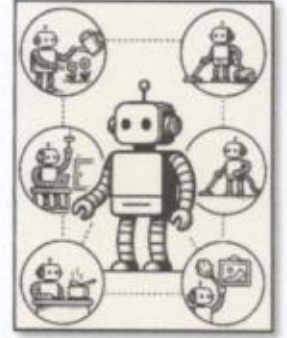

A robot is a machine that can be programmed to do specific tasks, sometimes even better than humans. While they do not think or feel like people, robots were originally designed in the early 20th century to make work faster, easier, and often safer. Many may not realise, but robots are now part of our daily lives.



One of the most common uses of robots is in households nowadays. Robotic vacuum cleaners, for example, can move around a home and clean the floors without much help from people. New types of robots are designed to assist the elderly or people with disabilities. They can remind someone to take medicine, carry objects, or even provide help with communication. These home robots save time and make life more comfortable for many families.

Robots are also widely used in industries. In car factories, robots help build vehicles by painting them and putting together parts with remarkable accuracy. This kind of work could be dangerous for humans, but robots can always handle it easily. **They** also work in warehouses, where they move heavy boxes, arrange items, and prepare them for shipping. By doing these jobs, robots increase safety and productivity in the workplace.

Healthcare is another important field where robots are making a difference. There are robots that assist doctors during surgeries by holding instruments firmly or reaching areas too small for human hands. Others are used to deliver medicines and supplies in hospitals. Recently, even robotic pets have been developed to comfort patients who feel lonely. These examples demonstrate how robots can improve health and save lives.

Although robots are useful, they also bring **challenges** and affect people negatively. Some people are concerned that robots may take over jobs and leave fewer opportunities for humans. Others believe that relying too much on robots might make people less skilled. However, most experts agree that if used wisely, robots can be effective tools to support human abilities rather than replace them. In the future, we can anticipate robots to become even more common, helping us in ways we might not yet imagine.
