Al Shaheed Park, located in Kuwait City, was built in the 1960s. It narrates the story, history, and culture of a land. It is the largest green park in Kuwait. Visitors can enjoy the fountains, the water pools, and the picturesque lakes. They can also enjoy the various artistic sculptures, which were made by local artists. **They** come in many sizes and from several materials. They are amazing.

Al Shaheed Park is open every day from 5 am to 10 pm except on Fridays when the park is open from 1 pm to 10 pm. There is no entrance fee but there are some park rules that should be observed. For example, children are not allowed to use their bicycles, skateboards, skates, or scooters inside the park. Also, parents should always pay attention to their children to ensure their safety.

Al Shaheed Park has two museums: The Remembrance Museum shows the most important moments that shaped the Kuwait nation. In the centre of the museum, four icons show the four most important battles in the history of Kuwait. The Habitat Museum displays the **richness** of the natural habitats of Kuwait. Before they get inside, visitors receive a "Seed Ticket" containing a chip that allows them to get information about that particular seed.

Al Shaheed Park is home to a big amount of history just waiting to be discovered. The Al-Shaab gate is one of the five gates of the old Kuwait Wall that are still standing, and it is widely considered to be the historical highlight of the park.
