The towers were closed for repairs in March 2012. They were re-opened on 8th March 2016, with a huge fireworks festival.

The main tower is 187 metres high and has two spheres. The lower sphere holds in its bottom half a water tank of 990,000 gallons. In its upper half, there is a restaurant that can seat 90 people, a coffee shop, a lounge, and a reception hall. The upper sphere, which rises to 123 metres above sea level, moves a full turn every 30 minutes and holds a coffee shop. The second tower is 147 metres high and used as a water tower. The third tower does not store water. It has equipment to light the two larger towers.


