
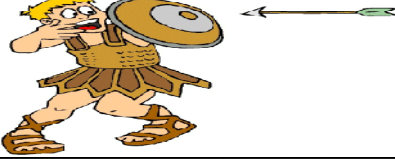

* Although : means " in spite of the fact that "

* However , : means " but "

Note : It is important to add a comma after " however , "

Ex: Although the watch was expensive , he bought it .

Ex: Sami passed the test . However, he didn't get the job .

is / are /am + present participle

Negative : isn't / aren't / am not + present participle

(We use present continuous to talk about future arrangements that are planned)

Ex: I'm having dinner with friends tonight .






Ex: She is meeting Omar at the train station tomorrow .
