



Many spiders like to lay their eggs in their webs. The webs keep the eggs together. They help spiders keep their eggs safe. Most spiders are dark. They are brown, grey, or black. But spider webs are light. They are white and cloudy to help spiders hide. When spiders hide in their webs, they are harder to see.

Webs help spiders catch food. Spider webs are sticky. When a bug flies into the web, it gets stuck. It moves around. It tries to get out but it can't because it is **trapped!** Spiders can tell that the bug is caught. That's because spiders feel the web move. when the spider is hungry, it goes to get the bug.

As you can see, webs help spiders hold eggs. They also help spiders hide and catch food. Without webs, spiders would not be able to live. **They** need their webs to survive!
