Did you know that dolphins are mammals? The word "mammals" means that they give birth and feed their young with milk. A dolphin breathes through a hole on top of its head. They have to come up to the surface to breathe. Most dolphins surface every few minutes, but they can stay under water for up to 15 minutes. Dolphins' colour is generally grey with darker backs than the rest of their bodies. Dolphins have a thick layer of fat under their skin. They need **it** to keep warm because they don't have fur like land animals.

Dolphins live in families which are usually led by a female dolphin. The dolphins in a family help each other, for example when raising their young. When travelling or hunting, several families might join together to make a larger group, also known as a school of dolphins. Most dolphin **species** have a long lifespan. In the wild, dolphins can live up to 50 years old, although the average age is 17 years.

Dolphins use echolocation to navigate and to find food :fish. Dolphins send out clicks that are returned from other objects in the water (just like an echo). This way a dolphin can locate food, other dolphins, or rocks.

Dolphins live in seawater but there are some species that live in fresh water: the river dolphins. Unfortunately, river dolphins are endangered and it is feared that one species, the "baiji", has already died out.


