Cobras usually raise their heads when they are scared and ready to attack. They hunt and look for food in the evening and at night. They feed on birds, other snakes, lizards and frogs. When Cobras lay their eggs, they build a nest to put them in and protect them until they hatch.

There are more than 40 kinds of Cobras. King Cobra is one of the deadliest. It is extremely **venomous** and have enough poison that can kill 20 people. The longest one can reach 18 feet long. They usually live for 20 years and are found mostly in India.

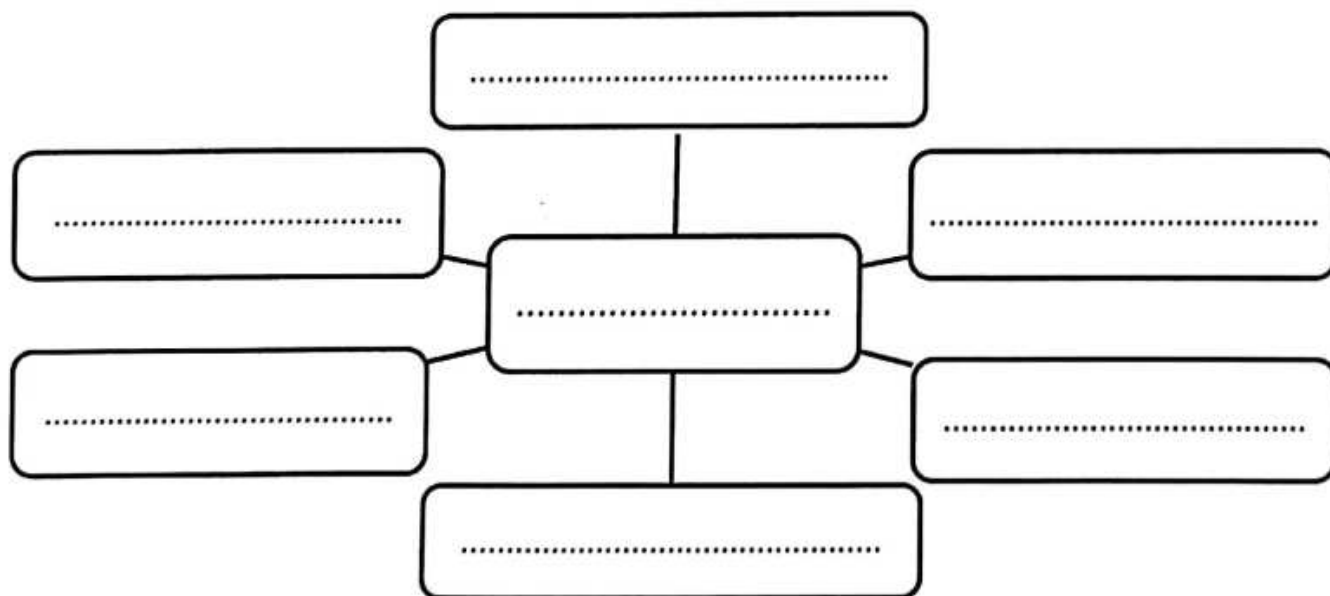
