Reading Comprehension (110 marks)

Doctors say that there are several kinds of headaches. Each kind begins in a different place and needs different treatment. Some of these headaches start with a change in vision or sight. The person sees wavy lines, black dot, or white spots in front of the eyes. This is a warning that a headache is coming. The headache occurs on only one side of the head. The vision is blurred and the person may vomit from the pain. These headaches are called the migraine headaches. They are more frequent in women than men. Sleep is the best cure for **them**

Cluster headaches, which also start in the arteries, are called cluster headaches because they come in clusters or groups. A cluster headache lasts only for two hours and then goes away. At the beginning of the cluster headache, the eyes become red and watery. There is a steady pain in the head. Men have more cluster headaches than women do.

The muscle headache, which starts in the muscles in the neck or forehead, is caused by tension. When the person becomes nervous about something, or has problems at work, or at school, or at home, the neck and head muscles become **tense** and the headache starts. A muscle headache usually starts in the morning and gets worse as the hours pass. There is a steady pain, pressure and a bursting feeling. Usually, aspirin doesn't help a muscle very much.

How do doctors treat headaches? If a person has frequent headaches, the doctor first has to decide what kind they are. Medicine can help, but there are other ways to treat them. The doctor asks the patient to analyze his or her daily living patterns. A change in diet, or an increase in exercise might stop the headaches. If the patient realizes that difficulties at home, or at work, or at school are causing the tension, it might be possible to make changes and decrease these problems. Psychological problems and even medicine for another physical problem can cause headache. The doctor has to discuss and analyze all these patterns of the patient's life. A headache can be also a signal of a more serious problem. So, patient should realize that there is no magic cure for headaches, but doctors can control most of them.

VI- Reading Comprehension (110 Marks)

Read the following passage carefully, then answer the questions below:

Our world was a lot different just a few decades ago. People spent more time outdoors. But today, video games and hundreds of TV channels often compete with walking in the park or planting a garden. Safety fears, pollution, and limited green spaces in cities also keep many people indoors.

Young people now spend about six hours a day in front of a TV or a computer and less than four minutes playing outdoors. That statistic comes from the U.S. Department of the Interior, an agency that manages many of the nation's parks. Not that technology is bad—but it is not healthy for the mind and the body when time spent on technology replaces outdoor time, says Dr. Daphne Miller, a family doctor who also teaches medicine at the University of California, San Francisco.

Many health experts call the problem of kids not spending enough time outdoors "nature deficit disorder." Scientific studies support the claims that a nature deficit can harm the mind and the body, and some health experts have started calling green time "vitamin G." Kids who don't get outdoors much are more likely to have attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and depression. They also tend to have trouble in school. Doctors believe that is because being outdoors <u>stimulates</u> the mind more than sitting around indoors. Even those who usually spend a lot of time outdoors notice a difference when they don't get enough green time.

Studies by Cornell University environmental psychologist Nancy Wells show that kids who have easy access to nature areas cope with stress better. They adapt faster when they move to a new place, and fight less with family members. The studies also indicate that kids who move to places with more green space do better at school and that spending time outside helps **improve** symptoms for kids with depression and ADHD.

The U.S. government launched the America's Great Outdoors programmes to help make more outdoor spaces and activities safe and accessible to all. Those programmes are encouraging people to try fun outdoor activities such as hiking and swimming at parks, beaches, forests, and farms. According to America's Great Outdoors, Americans report better health, greater happiness, and more quality family time when **they** get more green time.

Doctors have started giving their patients a dose of vitamin G. Dr. Miller writes "park prescriptions" for her patients because, she says, "being outdoors is good for your health." She finds that when she gives patients prescriptions, they tend to accept them willingly. Her prescriptions tell people exactly where to go, how often, and how long to stay active.

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VI-Reading Comprehension (110 marks)

Read the following passage and answer the questions below:

Aileen Riggin was born in 1906. Her father was in the navy serving in Philippines. There, she learned to swim at age 6. Around age 11, as she recovered from the flu, her doctor recommended swimming to rebuild her strength. Diving became one of her favourite activities. At that time, many people feared diving as it was too dangerous for women and girls. So, most indoor swimming pools would not let Aileen practise her lovable sport. Aileen decided to find other ways to practice her favourite sport. She joined the U.S Olympic trials. She used an outdoor tide pool; where ocean water gathered between rocks. Female divers dived there. They had to wait for the high tide to practise diving. When conditions were perfect, the tide pool was just like a real swimming pool!

At age 14 Aileen qualified for the 1920 U.S Olympic diving and swim team. Thanks to her qualification, she was able to travel around the world. On the 13-day journey to Belgium, Aileen practised swimming in a small swimming pool to be physically prepared for the competitions. Conditions at the Olympic Games were not much better since Belgium was still **recovering** from World War I. The outdoor pools were so muddy, Aileen was afraid that when she dived in, she would get stuck at the bottom forever. During the competition, she overcame her fears and won the gold medal in diving! She became the youngest Olympic gold medalist of her time at age 14.

At the 1924 Olympics in Paris, Aileen again competed in both swimming and diving. She won a silver medal for the 3 metre-springboard event and a bronze medal in the 100 metre-backstroke competition, making her the first person to earn medals in both diving and swimming in the same Olympic year.

Aileen made films, performed all over the world, and later became a sportswriter and she never stopped swimming. At age 85, she broke six world records for her group at the World Masters Swimming Championships. She continued to swim well into her nineties. Up to her death at age 96, she was the oldest living female Olympic medalist.
