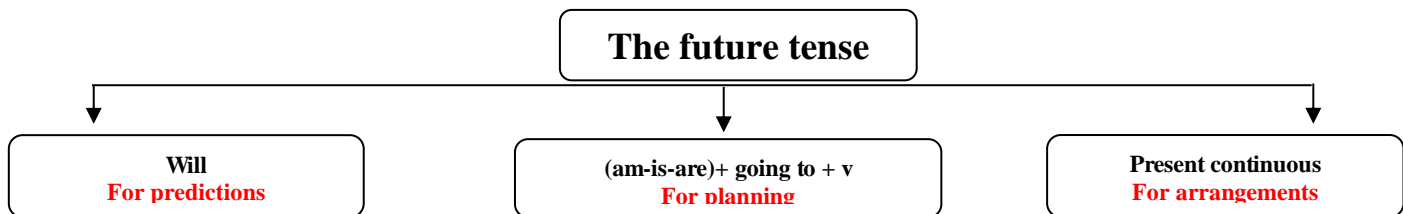

A brain has many different parts that work together, for example, the Cerebrum, Brain Stem, Pituitary Gland and Hypothalamus. The biggest part of the brain is the cerebrum. It was one of those terribly hot days in Baltimore. We always had those for a month between July and August. That day was particularly hotter than I could remember it had ever been. The weatherman on the radio said the temperature would reach 104°!

We returned the next day and saw the same two movies again, twice more. And we did it the next day too.
